

ENHANCED SANITATION PRACTICES & SOCIAL DISTANCING GUIDELINES

For the safety of our dancers and staff, we are incorporating extensive new and improved sanitation practices at The Dance Space. The following protocol is in addition to our existing standard cleaning procedures.

Cleaning/Sanitizing BETWEEN each Class and End of Day:

We have organized time between many classes to help facilitate cleaning. This thorough cleaning includes but is not limited to all studios, all entrances/doorways, any handheld props, any area touched by dancers, restrooms, and any common areas dancer use. We have trained all employees on the proper protocols for cleaning. Dancers will not be permitted into the rooms until the cleaning is complete. At the end of each day, all floors and restrooms will be thoroughly sanitized in addition to daily sanitizing standards.

Spot Cleaning as Needed:

Staff members have access to cleaning supplies, disinfectant, hand sanitizer, and have been instructed to clean any areas needed during class, should it be necessary.

Handheld Props:

The use of handheld props will be limited, however should we choose to use them they will be thoroughly cleaned and sanitized after each use.

Hand Washing Requirements:

Anyone who uses the restroom facility will be required to thoroughly wash hands with soap upon exiting the restroom. All staff members have been trained on proper hand hygiene and will be required to use hand sanitizer or wash hands with soap after each group leaves the area where they are stationed.

Lobby Use:

Our Lobby will be CLOSED for all AFTERNOON parents and spectators. Once a month we will film and send home a video of each class to showcase what they are learning in class settings. Our Lobby will be OPEN for morning preschool dance classes and we ask that spectators maintain a socially distant space and wear a mask. Office functions will be best handled via email and phone.

Temperature Check and Hand Sanitizer Upon Entry:

Upon entry to each designated area within The Dance Space, we will take dancer's temperature and will provide and require hand sanitizer on each dancer's hands.

Mask:

We are asking that dancers/families wear a mask upon entering The Dance Space and our lobby areas. Once dancers are settled into their dance rooms, masks are NOT required by participants or instructors. When dancers or staff members are rotating around our lobby space/hallways masks will be worn during the transition times.

Water:

If your dancer needs water during class time, we recommend bringing your own water bottle. Our water fountains will be unavailable for use.

Entrance/Exit Points:

Once your dancer has been enrolled in a class, we will advise you on the places where your dancer will enter and exit the building for their class each week. We have 6 entry and exit points at TDS and we feel that creating a flow of less people in and out of the Entrance/Exit points will help to keep us safe.

Limited Items In The Studio/Changing Clothes:

Dancers will be limited to one average sized dance bag/backpack and must keep them in a designated area. We encourage dancers to come ready for class and refrain from using the restrooms for changing clothes before or after classes.
